课程介绍 Course Description

1.1 内容 Context

Chinese economy has achieved a continuously high growth since 1978. It attracts the global attention both from the academia and the industry. Recently, there is a rising concern on the sustainability of China's growth as its growth rate has started to slow down after 2008. We hold that the reform and opening is the driving force of Chinese economy since 1978, and Chinese economy still possesses adequate growth potential after 2008. However, the future focus shall be directed to the reform of economic structure and social policies.

This course tries to expand on my above premise, providing a complete picture of the Chinese economy. There are four distinctive features of this course. First, I will use a few lectures covering the basic introduction of Chinese economy Second, I will invite a few experts specialized in different economic sectors to give us speeches from industrial eyes. Third, I will organize students to visit a few companies and or factories to deepen our understandings of Chinese economy. Fourth, students need to finish term papers and presentations in groups, on topics related to Chinese economy, to help each other to understand Chinese economy more comprehensively.

After this course, students shall obtain a thorough understanding of Chinese economy, as well as gain the skills to find relevant data and form opinions. Preferably, students may find their interested topics for the future research.
