You can find here the list of countries which are exempt from visa. http://www.esca.ma/en/international/practical_details</p> <p>If your country is not on this list, then you should apply for a visa from the Moroccan consulate in your country and present these documents :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application form duly filled • Identity card or stay card • Valid passport • 3 identity photos • Acceptance letter <p>The period of stay in Morocco for foreigners who are exempted from visa is limited to 3 months. You need to extend your stay on the Moroccan territory at least 10 days before the expiration of the 3 months. You have to request for an authorization from the General Office of National Security with the same documents as above in addition to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The rental agreement which must be in your name. • A copy of the entry stamp in Moroccan territory <p>If the incoming student leaves the territory of Morocco during the 3 months and comes back, his stay will be systematically extended for other 3 months.</p>
