You need to extend your stay on the Moroccan territory at least 10 days before the expiration of the 3 months. You have to request for an authorization from the General Office of National Security with the same documents as above in addition to: The rental agreement which must be in your name. A copy of the entry stamp in Moroccan territory If the incoming student leaves the territory of Morocco during the 3 months and comes back, his stay will be systematically extended for other 3 months.
