Language of Instruction: All MBA courses are taught in English.

Academic/Experience: Second year MBA candidates only. First year MBA core

courses are not available to exchange students.

Acceptance of Nominations: To maintain educational exchange balance, UC Davis Graduate

> School of Management is only able to host one student from each partner university every other academic year. In the case where a UC Davis Graduate School of Management student participates in exchange with a partner university, a 1:1

exchange within consecutive academic years is possible.



Visa Requirements: Exchange students are required to have a J-1 visa

Full-time Workload: All exchange students are required to take at least 12 quarter

units. Each credit is equal to 10 class contact hours. Most electives are 3 quarter units, with some 1-unit and 2-unit

courses.

Grading: Letter grading: A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D, F. C- is

considered a passing grade. Class attendance is mandatory. Grades are mailed to the home university campus for each

exchange student at the end of the quarter.

Exchange students are welcome to attend fall, winter or spring quarters. There are no exchange opportunities during

the summer.

Expenses: On-campus housing is very limited and most MBA students

live off-campus. Monthly rents vary based on number of roommates and amenities selected. Average rent for unfurnished one bedroom apartments are approximately \$1000/month. Students are responsible for purchasing all

textbooks. Cost of books will vary. Services for

International Services fee is approximately \$160 per

quarter.

Health Insurance: The University of California requires that all students have

health insurance. UC Davis automatically enrolls all registered students in the Graduate Student Health Insurance Plan (GSHIP). Fees for GSHIP coverage are charged to your student account each school term. Fees run about \$1,500. If you have comparable health insurance and do not want to be enrolled in GSHIP, you may apply for a

SHIP waiver.

Campus Resources: Exchange students are issued a UC Davis student ID card.

With this ID card, students can use all facilities on campus,

e.g. library, Activities & Recreation Center, etc.

Career Development: Most Career Development services are available to exchange

students during the exchange period only.

Student Services: All student club events are open to exchange students.
