-Visa-

Depending on your home country, you could need a visa or not. You can find here the list of countries which are exempt from visa.

If your country is not on this list, then you should apply for a visa from the Moroccan consulate in your country and present these documents:

- Application form duly filled
- Identity card or stay card
- Valid passport
- 3 identity photos
- Acceptance letter

The period of stay in Morocco for foreigners who are exempted from visa is limited to 3 months. You need to extend your stay on the Moroccan territory at least 10 days before the expiration of the 3 months. You have to request for an authorization from the General Office of National Security with the same documents as above in addition to:

- The rental agreement which must be in your name.
- A copy of the entry stamp in Moroccan territory

If the incoming student leaves the territory of Morocco during the 3 months and comes back, his stay will be systematically extended for other 3 months.
