ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

German Language requirements

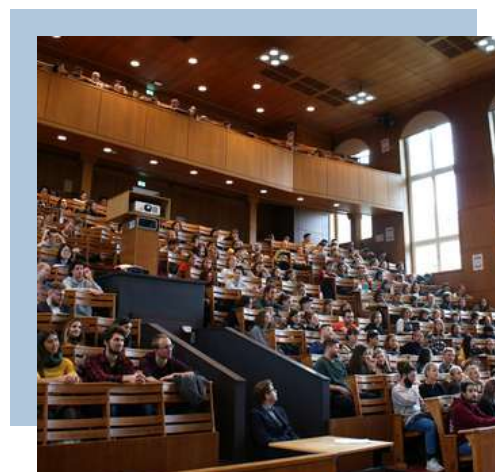
The required level of German language skills is B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and can be proven by submitting a Goethe-Zertifikat B2/C1, DSH or TestDaF.

Alternatively students can do an online language placement test (C-Test); required score: 60 points. If students fail to achieve the required score, they have the option to enroll in an Intensive Language Course (550 €) prior to the start of the semester. To apply for that Course the result of the C-Test requires a minimum score of 45 points.

English Language requirements

Master's students must demonstrate English proficiency at level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The language of instruction in all SBE master's programmes is English.
