Founded in 2010, **Nanyan News Agency**, is a student news team composed of master's and doctoral students. Over the past fifteen years, adhering to the mission of "**Chronicling PKU's Legacy, Illuminating Its Spirit**", the agency has continuously expanded its communication channels and innovated storytelling methods, remaining at the forefront of reporting on **Peking University's development and the Construction of Guangdong-Hong Kong-Marco Greater Bay Area**.

Over the past year alone, Nanyan News Agency has **planned, coordinated, and participated in over 400 projects**, including articles, photos, and videos, with **total views exceeding 1.08 million and interactions (shares, likes, and favorites) surpassing 21,000**. Student Green Plus Association of PKUSZ (Green+), founded in 2016, is a representative and pioneering environmental public welfare and practice-oriented student organization. Open to students from Peking University, Tsinghua University, Harbin Institute of Technology, Southern University of Science and Technology, Shenzhen University, and others, Green+ operates under the motto “Building bridges between students and society; exploring pathways toward a green future.” Green + has experienced rapid growth since its establishment. It has been **honored multiple times as “the Leading Club”, “the Brand Club” in PKUSZ and “the Outstanding Student Club” in Shenzhen.**

In recent years, Green+ has organized signature programs across six key areas—Campus, Education, Practice, Public Welfare, Society, and International—including the Clean Plate Campaign, Green Graduation Season, outreach to primary and secondary schools, "Face to Face" tea talks with academicians, corporate visits, and mangrove conservation fieldwork. By collaborating extensively with fellow student associations, Party and League branches, government departments, community groups, and NGOs, Green+ has become the vanguard of sustainable action among PKU students.

Green+ also cultivates an international perspective through participation in the International Conference on Sustainable Development and Social Responsibility, the World Circular Economy Forum, the International Climate Film & TV Conference, and the China session of the UN Youth Climate Summit. Green+ is more than an association—it’s a green family of idealists, responsible leaders, and warm hearts. Join us!

Green Graduation | Used Item Collection & Charity Sale

During the June 2025 graduation, Green+ partnered with the Nanshan District Urban Management Bureau to collect idle items, offer waste-sorting education, and showcase intelligent recycling equipment. At the graduation carnival in University Town, Green+ represented PKUSZ with a booth for swapping and selling second-hand items. This “gift + charity sale” model received coverage from multiple media outlets, including Shenzhen News Network.



World Food Day | Clean Plate, Count Me In

In October 2024, Green+ issued an appeal to students of Peking University, Tsinghua University, and Harbin Institute of Technology in University Town to eliminate “food waste at the tip of the tongue,” and posted “Clean Plate” slogans in prominent locations within the dining halls, sparking an enthusiastic response. Numerous Nanyan students took part in the prize-based “Clean Plate Check-In” activity.



Into Primary and Secondary Schools | Green Sprouts

Green+ initiative regularly dispatches PKU students to primary and secondary schools for interactive environmental education. Its “Green Sprouts Action” lectures cover topics like waste sorting, low-carbon living, and ecosystem protection—engaging over 3,000 students and teachers and earning a feature in Shekou News. In collaboration with SUSTech Experimental School, it also runs the “Big Hands Hold Small Hands” civic education program.

Student Public Interest Law Foundation of PKUSZ

Association Profile

Public Interest Law Foundation (PILF) is a student organization under the joint guidance of the Communist Youth League Committee of Peking University Shenzhen Graduate School and Peking University School of Transnational Law. It aims to promote public interest legal practice among students, focusing on legal publicity, legal aid, institutional visits, and public welfare funding.

Last academic year, the association handled 76 legal aid cases, with clients across 28 Chinese provinces; hosted the first Greater Bay Area Youth Legal Service Capacity-Building Seminar and organized over 20 public interest legal activities, collaborating with Peking University Affiliated High School Shenzhen, University Town Community etc. PILF was awarded the "Leading Student Association" by the Communist Youth League Committee of Peking University Shenzhen Graduate School (ranking first in the graduate school). This year, it won the title of "Brand Student Association" with a top-three ranking.

The association currently has five departments: General Affairs, Project Operations, Legal Consultation, Academic Development, and Public Relations & Communication. The Legal Consultation Department achieves 72-hour case response; the Academic Development Department has completed 10 typical case analyses. PILF boasts a sound system of brand activities, including the Annual Public Interest Law Auction, regular legal consultation services, campus legal publicity lectures, and mock court collaborations. In the future, PILF will launch various new legal aid columns—stay tuned!

Public Interest Law Auction | Charity Bidding & Pro Bono Legal Aid

Through the auction, donated items, and the public gain new meaning, spreading warmth with each bid. As a platform to gather goodwill, it channels legal expertise into public welfare. All proceeds fund pro bono initiatives: legal aid for vulnerable groups and community/campus legal education. Every donation and bid becomes a heartwarming stride in advancing rule-of-law philanthropy.



Community Legal Promotion | Festival - Themed Advocacy & Rights Protection

Community legal promotion transforms legal expertise into accessible guardianship guides. Aligned with milestones like Women's Day and International Anti-Domestic Violence Day, it zeroes in on themes such as anti-domestic violence and youth legal education. By converting legal provisions into relatable dialogues, it equips residents with practical rights-protection knowledge, fortifying the rule-of-law defense for families and communities.



Free Legal Aid | Free Consultation & Public - Benefiting Assistance

Free legal consultations serve community residents, students, faculty, and the public, focusing on marital and family rights protection, labor dispute mediation, and property safety. Professional legal teams provide end - to - end support: statutory application analysis, evidence collection guidance, and rights - defense planning. Through regular consultation channels and themed legal promotion mechanisms, we integrate justice into daily life.



Number and requirements of new recruits

Expected to recruit about 150 students

- Align with PILF's public - interest philosophy, and be willing to act to explore how law empowers social services. Open to all academic backgrounds—only a public - service - minded heart is needed.
- Show basic willingness to learn. Acquire skills like legal publicity and simple consultation guidance through association - provided training, and embrace legal public - interest practice with an open mind.
- Demonstrate team - work awareness: participate in basic tasks (event planning, material preparation, etc.), accept cross - departmental assignments, and proactively contribute in teamwork.
- Devote monthly time to regular legal aid work (e.g., legal publicity, consultations). Flexibly adjust schedules for large - scale events, collaborating while prioritizing academic commitments.
- Abide by association rules; strictly safeguard privacy of public - service data (e.g., legal aid case details, donation records).

Student Stray Cat Care Association of PKUSZ

Association Profile

The Student Stray Cat Care Association of PKUSZ was established in January 2024. As the youngest student organization in PKUSZ, we passionately dedicate ourselves to the rescue of stray cat. In just a year and a half, we have achieved remarkable growth and breakthroughs, forming a relatively complete stray cat rescue system.

Our members regularly check on stray cats and feed them scientifically. We are familiar with cats' habits, personalities and activity trajectories, also do TNR (Trap - Neuter - Return) for unsterilized ones. In addition, our association actively seek resources, run social media and design cultural - creative products to cover expenses for sick and injured cats. By promoting the concept of scientific feeding, we advocate against abandonment. We've partnered with national institutions, gained over 3,000 followers on Xiaohongshu. Now, many products are actively donated for cat feeding, we also achieved a 100% sterilization rate in campus, and found homes for 20 stray cats.

However, stray cat rescue is tough than imagined.. We hope more kind - hearted students will join us to protect these little lives. We hope that with love and responsibility, we can build a warm haven for stray cats, and look forward to seeing the little cats every day.

Daily Feeding | Experiencing the Tender Dialogue between Different Species

The essence of feeding is "guarding tenderness with rationality". We need to warm their stomachs with food and protect their living conditions with scientific methods.

When every feeding is accompanied by awareness of sterilization, hygiene, and observation, we can truly build a warm protective net for stray cats.



Sterilization and Release | Love is not Indulgence, but Responsibility

TNR is a scientific and humane method for managing stray cat populations. Through sterilization, it improves the survival quality of cats, and reduces the impact on the ecological environment.

TNR work is continuous. After completed sterilization of campus cat, new stray cats will enter the campus to claim living space. Therefore, TNR is a long - term task.



Products & Promotion | One More Understanding and Support, One More Lifeline

To cover the fee for daily and emergency disease treatment of stray cats, we sell original products like cat - themed badges, canvas bags, postcards, keychains, etc. Through charity sales, we call on people to pay attention to the situation of stray cats.

The road is long, but with love, we fear no distance.



Number and requirements of new recruits

- Group Support Department: Daily feeding, maintenance of feeding points, TNR, sending cats to the vet.
- Adoption Department: Matching adopters, screening adoption conditions.
- Propaganda Department: Charity sale, designing cultural - creative products, social media operation.
- External Liaison Department: Brand cooperation, communication and feedback.




2024 Peking-Tsinghua-HIT Tri-University Swimming Competition
