The 3rd PKU-NUS Annual International Conference on Quantitative Finance and Economics held in Beijing

On May 12 and 13, PHBS collaborated with the PKU Laboratory of Mathematical Economics and Quantitative Finance and the NUS Risk Management Institute to host the 3rd PKU-NUS Annual International Conference on Quantitative Finance and Economics. The event took place at PKU's Beijing campus with over 120 participants including members from industry and academia, as well as students. After review by an international panel of experts, 37 original and unpublished research papers on finance and economics were selected for presentation within seven conference sessions. Topics included actuarial science, algorithmic trading, computational finance, financial modelling, governance, liquidity and credit risk, as well as macro, micro, and monetary economics among others.
