STUDENT VISA

STUDENTS MUST BE ADMITTED TO OUR INSTITUTION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE DS-2019 FORM TO APPLY FOR THEIR VISA. THE ORIGINAL DS-2019 FORM IS REQUIRED IN ORDER TO START THE VISA APPLICATION PROCESS. FEES CAN VARY DEPENDING ON THE COUNTRY.



ON-CAMPUS HOUSING

STUDENTS ARE RECOMMENDED TO RESIDE ON CAMPUS. ON-CAMPUS HOUSING REQUIRES THE PURCHASE OF A MEAL PLAN.
